On Thursday 24th March, Otters will be taking part in a river trip and workshop organised by the Bristol and Avon River Trust (BART). It will be held on school premises and at the nearby Combe within the school day.

The BART are offering this free classroom workshop and riverbank visit designed for Year 5 and 6 primary school pupils as they believe our rivers are like veins of the countryside, providing our local wildlife with homes and food and providing us with a space to relax and enjoy. We hope this local river trip and workshop can inspire and capture the imagination of our young learners at East Harptree Primary School. This is a powerful opportunity to see STEM applied in practice.

The full day's activities will include:
