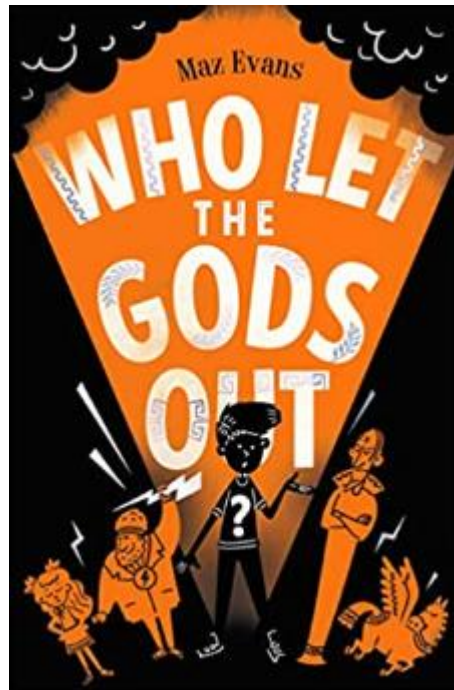
Don't forget **Adventurers Youth Group** restarts **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> January at West Harptree hall**. Open to years 3-6.
